### Beginning Hand Building Class

Joining the Clay Club involves completing a membership application and taking a Beginning Handbuilding Class. You will learn to hand-build, glaze, and fire several pieces. The class involves 24 hours of instruction, 4 hours/day spread over 3 weeks. The class fee includes all instruction, 25 lbs of clay for your projects, firing and glazing fees, and your club membership dues for the year.

Experienced potters may request to test out of the Beginning Hand Building Class.

**Please note:** Working in clay occasionally involves lifting 25-lb bags of clay and standing for prolonged periods of time.
