



Fashion Diva Dolls and Vases by Deb Gibilisco

Fashion Diva Dolls

1. Roll out a 12x16 piece of clay 3/8" thick. Apply paper to your cone.
2. Apply texture to your clay, then cut out pattern over the clay.
3. Have a turn table, small wear board. Put the textured cut clay piece on your cone. Score and Slip the edge, then smooth the seam.
4. Remove cone, score and slip the top, then pinch the top together. This will be the shoulders. Make a small pinch pot and inclose it, patting it till it's oval. This will be the head. Then make a coil 1 inch thick and 1 1/2 inch long. This will be the neck of the doll.
5. Smooth one end of the coil to the head, the other end smooth on top of the shoulders. Be sure to score and slip each end.
6. Apply hair, face, arms, breasts and a fashionable dress. Be sure to score and slip everything you add.

Diva Vase

1. Use a straight tube. Cover it with paper.
2. Put texture on your clay. Wrap around the tube. Score and slip the sides, then smooth.
3. Cut 4, 3 inch darts down around the top of the vase. Score and slip each of them and smooth. Pull out tube. Put bottom on. Make sure you score and slip each side.
4. Smooth the top 2 inches of vase for the face and hair. Score and slip everything you add.
