Desert Treasure

MATERIALS

- Heavily-cast greenware vase. (Mold #V362 Tear drop vase by Vista Ceramic Molds)
- Cleaning tools.
- Sgraffito tool.
- T-112 Cinnamon Tri-Tone underglaze color.
- V-369 Fawn Velvet underglaze color.
- BW-3006 Peat Brown Brush 'n Wipe.
- SP-510 Clear glaze.
- Reward Sun Burst stains—OS-75 Snow, OS-78 Ornament Blue, OS-83 Grass Green, OS-94 Natural Buff, OS-96 Cinnamon Stick, OS-98 Raven, OS-102 Fern Green, OS-103 Deep Avocado, and OS-113 Hot Chocolate.
- SB-22 matte spray fixative.
- Brushes—Series BL #3 mini round, Series BL #6 and #10 shaders, Series 7 #4 fan blender, Series 12 3/4" ox hair flat glaze, and Series 100 #2 white liner.
- Ultra Suede braids.
- Feathers.
- Turquoise stones.

Step 1 — Sketch or trace the brick areas onto the piece. Following the directions under *INCISING AND CARVING* in the introduction to this book, put in the brick areas.

Step 2 — Using the 3/4" ox hair flat glaze brush and avoiding

the brick areas, apply 3 coats of V-369 Fawn to the outside of the vase. Also apply the Fawn color as far down as possible to the inside of the neck.

Step 3 — Use the #3 mini round brush to apply 3 coats of T-112 Cinnamon regular underglaze color to the brick areas. Properly mix the BW-3006 Peat Brown Brush 'n Wipe and apply 1 coat of it to the brick areas with the #4 fan blender brush. Allow the Peat Brown color to dry, then use a soft cloth or tissue to wipe off the excess color for an antique effect.

Step 4 — Fire the piece to cone 05-04.

Step 5 — Pour slightly thinned SP-510 clear glaze into the vase and roll it around to evenly coat the inside. Drain out the excess glaze, and use a sponge to remove any glaze drips from the outside of the vase.

Step 6 — Fire the piece to cone 06-05.

Step 7 — Sketch or trace the pattern onto the piece.

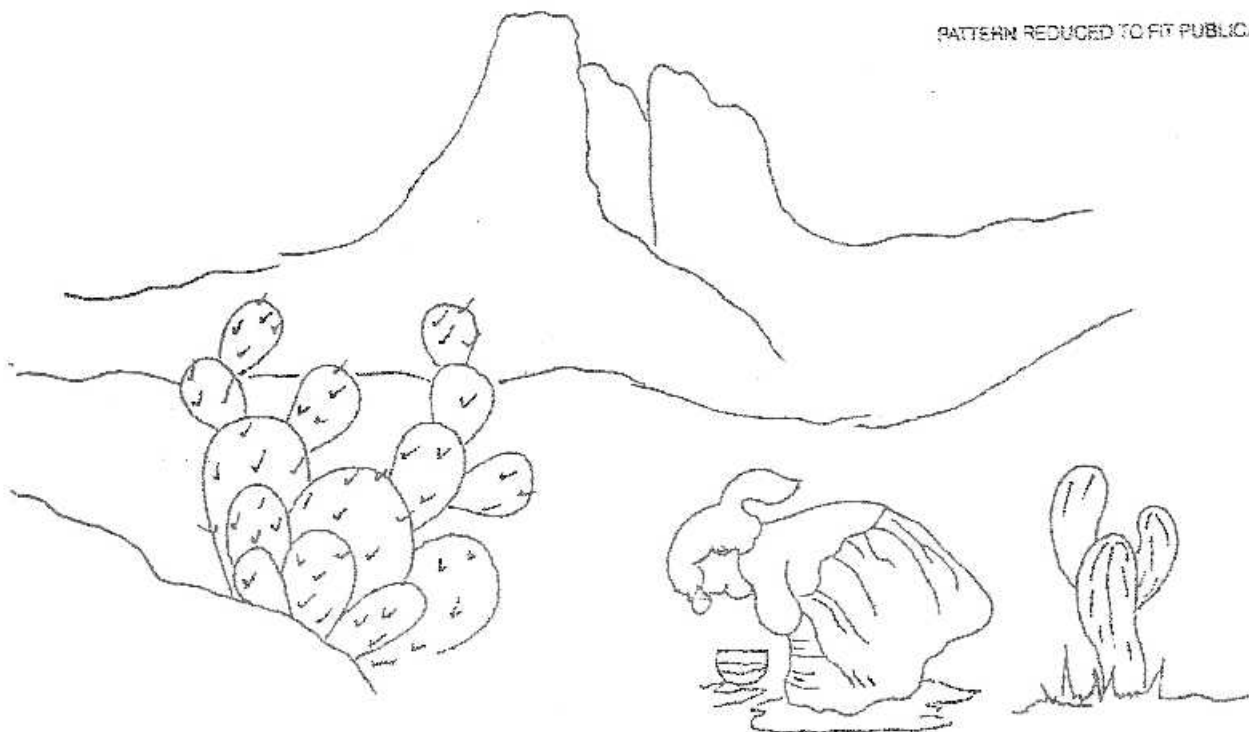
Step 8 — Side load the brush with the following colors of Sun Burst stains and shade the indicated areas:

- OS-113 Hot Chocolate—Mountains and ground areas.
- OS-102 Fern Green—Apply to cactus, then shade edges with OS-103 Deep Avocado.
- OS-94 Natural Buff—Skin areas.
- OS-75 Snow—Blouse.
- Mixture of OS-78 Ornament Blue and OS-83—Use this teal blue mixture to shade the skirt.
- OS-96 Cinnamon Stick—Design on pot.
- OS-Raven—Hair.

Step 9 — Use the #2 white liner brush and OS-98 Raven to shade and detail the entire design.

Step 10 — Spray 2 light coats of SB-22 matte fixative on the entire outside of the vase.

Step 11 — Trim the vase with Ultra Suede braids, feathers, and turquoise stones.
